SUBJECT: National Office of Job Corps 2004 Annual Alpha Leadership

Conference

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide information on the National Office of Job Corps 2004 Alpha Leadership Conference, July 26-28, 2004.

2. <u>Background</u>. The Alpha Leadership Conference is an annual gathering of select members of Job Corps' national, regional, center, OA/CTS, and contractor staff, and students. The conference provides a valuable opportunity to convey national priorities and provide staff training.

The National Office of Job Corps has scheduled this year's conference for July 26-28, 2004, at the Hyatt Regency Washington on Capitol Hill, in Washington, D.C. The conference will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, July 26th, and will conclude at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 28th.

The conference will involve workshops dedicated to leadership planning and technical assistance. It will focus on providing the system with training on key Job Corps initiatives and providing a forum for regional meetings.

This will be my final opportunity to thank Job Corps for the tremendous support I have been given as the National Director. I will address the Job Corps community on Tuesday, July 27, 2004, in a plenary session, and then on the morning of Wednesday,

July 28th, conference attendees will also have the opportunity to hear for the first time from the new National Director, Grace Kilbane.

Please note that the Job Corps Alpha Leadership Conference and the National Job Corps Association's (NJCA) Alpha Awards dinner and ceremony are <u>two separate events</u> and attendees must register for each event separately. - 3. <u>Conference Participants</u>. The following members of the Job Corps community should plan to attend the conference:
 - a. All Regional Directors, Regional Division Chiefs, and other key personnel;
 - b. All Center Directors, two additional center staff representatives, and three student ambassadors;
 - c. All OA/CTS key personnel;
 - d. All operators, support contractors' corporate staff, and National Training Contractors may send a number of representatives as appropriate.
- 4. <u>Job Corps National Student Leadership Conference</u>. During the week of the Alpha Leadership Conference, the Job Corps National Student Leadership Conference will be held for student participants. A separate Information Notice with more details on the Job Corps National Student Leadership Conference will follow.
