1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide the Job Corps community with the U.S. Department of Labor Manual Series (DLMS) 4, Chapter 800, DOL Safety and Occupational Health Program, revised November 7, 2007.

2. <u>Background</u>. Job Corps center operators, center directors, and safety officers are required to follow and refer to a number of policy and regulatory resources related to occupational safety and health in accordance with Job Corps Policy and Requirements Handbook (PRH) Chapter 5, Section 5.14, R2(f). One of the required resources, DLMS 4, Chapter 800, was revised in November 2007. It has come to the attention of the National Office that many centers are unaware of the revised DLMS 4, Chapter 800 and are using outdated materials.

3. <u>Action</u>. Job Corps center operators, center directors, and safety officers should reference the DLMS 4, Chapter 800 (dated November 7, 2007) and destroy any and all previous versions of the DLMS. This document will be made available on the Job Corps Community Web site under Safety Information \rightarrow Safety Resources.
