- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To inform the Job Corps community of mandatory sustainability Webinars, to highlight Job Corps centers' sustainability performance, and to publicize the results of Job Corps' Energy Action Month contests.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. This Information Notice addresses multiple sustainability items. First, the Office of Job Corps (OJC) has planned a Webinar on sustainability. The purposes are to provide information on the benefits of integrating sustainable practices with operations, address existing and new requirements, and to highlight best practices.

Second, we are highlighting centers' performance on energy, water, and waste measures. See Attachments A, B, and C. Note that this information is also posted and updated at the Funded Not Corrected Web site, available through the "Funded Not Corrected" application in Job Corps Citrix. The waste charts reflect initial data from centers; these data are expected to change over time as centers improve their measurements.

Finally, we also are recognizing the winners of two contests held during Energy Action Month, last October. For the Sustainability Project Contest, the Pittsburgh, Glenmont, and Gary Job Corps Centers deserve special recognition. For the Oldest Refrigerator Contest, Keystone was the clear winner. There were many strong entries for these contests. The Office of Job Corps appreciates the efforts of all applicants and regions, and will work with the winners and their regions on funding additional projects and improvements. 3. <u>Action</u>. All Job Corps centers and Regional Offices must attend the mandatory Sustainability Webinar. Facilities managers and at least one regional representative are required to attend one of the Webinars listed below. Finance and administration managers and other

personnel involved in the procurement of supplies and facilities maintenance should attend as well.
