SEPARATELY METERED BUILDINGS IN ENERGY WATCHDOG

Job Corps centers must enter energy and water data from separately metered buildings in Energy Watchdog. This reporting is required by the Department of Energy, Federal Energy Management Program.

The Engineering Support Contractor needs to know which accounts are metered separately by building. We will add these accounts in Energy Watchdog for you to fill in. Several centers have been entering this data already. Please provide this information even if your Energy Watchdog account already shows all separately metered buildings.

For example, if the Hamilton Job Corps Center has the following electric meters on center.
