Revisions to Support Chlamydia Testing in Males

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To update the policy on chlamydia testing in males.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. Chlamydial infections are the most prevalent of all sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) reported to the Center for Disease Control (CDC). With the advent of the new, highly sensitive nucleic acid amplification tests that can be performed on urine, symptomatic and asymptomatic (they display no symptoms) males are increasingly being diagnosed with chlamydial infections. In the past years, the rate of chlamydial infections in males has increased 71.9% nationally. Untreated chlamydial infections in males can cause other infections and sterility.

Job Corps policy has been to test all females for chlamydia on entry and when clinically indicated, and to screen all males for leukocyte esterase and, if positive, to collect a specimen to be tested for chlamydia. Effective immediately, all males will be tested for chlamydia on entry by the nationally contracted laboratory.

3. <u>Explanation of Changes</u>. Highlights of PRH changes are as follows:

Revise PRH 6.10, R1(c), Entrance Laboratory Testing Requirements, Males Only:

- Remove from inside the parentheses "Chlamydia and" found after Urinalysis (Dipstick) for Leukocyte Esterase.
- Remove "(if leukocyte esterase screen is positive)" after Chlamydia Testing.
