SUBJECT:	PRH Chapter 3, Section 3.7: Career Success Standards

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To inform the Job Corps community of policy changes regarding the Career Success Standards (CSS) and positive center culture.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. The Career Success Standards National Training Conferences were held in 2006. The Job Corps community is currently incorporating the Standards into their Career Development Services System (CDSS) plans to respond to Policy and Requirements Handbook (PRH) requirements and to meet the implementation deadline of June 27, 2007.

Feedback received during the National Training Conferences and subsequent information gathered from centers and Regional Offices revealed that effective implementation of the Standards produces a positive, normative center culture. Therefore, the need became apparent to modify the PRH to reflect the importance of center culture. In addition, a technical assistance section is being developed on the CSS Web site, available at http://jccdrc.jobcorps.gov/CSS, to help centers assess and improve center culture.

- 3. <u>Explanation of Changes</u>. Highlights of changes to Section 3.7 are as follows:
 - a. P1. shall now read: To provide students with a center culture that regularly fosters opportunities to learn and practice a set of behavioral expectations that support employability and social development for career success.
 - b. Add new Q3: Students and staff are partners in sustaining a center culture that is safe, welcoming, and supportive for all students, staff, and visitors.
