Modified Electronic Policy and Requirements Handbook Section 5.1,

Program Management.

Office of Job Corps

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To modify Electronic Policy and Requirements Handbook (ePRH) Section 5.1, R2, (c), Program Management, to clarify that Regional Office Center Assessments (ROCAs) will occur twice during the life of a contract, ideally during year 2 and year 4, and the visits may be unannounced. Targeted assessments may also be unannounced as well.
 - 2. <u>Background</u>. The ePRH Section 5.1, R2, (c) states, "Conduct annual comprehensive assessments of center or OA/CTS operations. Job Corps Regional Offices shall: Conduct assessments on a need-based and risk management schedule. Every center shall have two full assessments during the life of a contract, ideally during year 2 and year 5. Centers should be assessed annually if they are on a Performance Improvement Plan (PIP). Targeted assessments, which may also be unannounced, will focus on program areas that are found deficient in the initial or full assessment, or identified as potential causes of concern."
- 3. Explanation of change. ePRH Section 5.1, R2, (c)
 - ROCAs will occur twice during the life of a contract, on a need-based and risk management schedule, instead of annually.
 - Ideally, ROCAs will be conducted during contract year 2 and contract year 4.
 - ROCAs and targeted assessments may be conducted unannounced.
- 4. Action Required. Addressees must ensure appropriate staff receive this Change Notice.
