Spring Break 2020 COVID-19 Leave

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To add Spring Break 2020 Leave COVID-19 On-Center and Off-Center Leave Categories to Exhibit 6-1 Duty/Pay/Leave Status Chart.

<u>Background</u>. Job Corps established a spring break for all Job Corps centers in light of COVID-19 concerns and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines. Job Corps continues to communicate with contractors and other stakeholders, monitor the activities of the state and local jurisdictions regarding school closures and other COVID-19 related activities, and review CDC guidance on responding to COVID-19 in school settings.

This Change Notice incorporates spring break into the PRH and assigns it a leave status.
