SUBJECT: Implementation of the Rule on Equal Treatment in Department of

Labor Programs for Faith-Based and Community Organizations; Protection of Religious Liberty of Department of Labor Social Service

Providers and Beneficiaries

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To notify the Job Corps system of the new Final Rule relating to policy regarding students engaging in religious activities and related issues.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. Incorporated below is the Internet link to review the Final Rule on Equal Treatment in Department of Labor Programs for Faith-Based and Community Organizations; Protection of Religious Liberty of Department of Labor Social Service Providers and Beneficiaries. The Final Rule will be effective 30 days after its date of publication (July 12, 2004). At that time, the Rule will become Job Corps policy, and the current Policy and Requirements Handbook (PRH) language concerning the issue of religious expression (PRH 6.9, R2) will be suspended until new PRH language consistent with the Final Rule is developed.
- 3. <u>Action</u>. All interested parties are invited to comment on the change in policy and identify operational issues and other challenges. **Please submit comments by July 23, 2004**. Comments will help inform workgroup members in the development of new PRH language consistent with the Rule.
