SUBJECT:	Survey of Computer Systems Containing Personally Identifiable Information of Job Corps Students

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To identify all computer systems that contain Personally Identifiable Information (PII) of Job Corps students.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. Recent events reported in the media underscore the potentially serious consequences of lapses in maintaining the security of PII (e.g., names, social security numbers, etc.). Safeguarding sensitive information is a critical responsibility that must be taken seriously at all times. It is of paramount importance to identify all computer systems that may contain PII of Job Corps students, including:
  - a. Any computer systems that collect and/or store any personal data of Job Corps students, and from which the student's identity is apparent, or can reasonably be ascertained.
  - b. Any corporate/agency-developed, center-developed or 3<sup>rd</sup> party vendor-developed systems, including small homegrown systems using Access, ACT, or other tools.

The attached survey should be completed for **each** computer system that contains Job Corps students' personal data.

NOTE: Systems developed and managed by the Job Corps Data Center (JCDC) are not included in this survey.

- 3. <u>Action</u>. The addressees are to ensure that a copy of this Program Instruction is distributed to the appropriate staff. National Office Division Chiefs, Regional Directors, and contractor corporate representatives are responsible for ensuring that the attached survey is completed for each of the systems. The surveys should be completed electronically and saved to a file. The file should then be sent by e-mail to Linda Estep at <a href="mailto:estep.linda@jobcorps.org">estep.linda@jobcorps.org</a> no later than July 21, 2006.
