SUBJECT: Mandatory Job Corps Fleet Management Training for Contractor Operated

Center Fleet Personnel

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To inform the Job Corps community of mandatory training regarding Job Corps Fleet Management policies.

- 2. <u>Background</u>. On April 20, 2000, Executive Order (E.O.) 13149, was issued to direct federal agencies to reduce petroleum fuel consumption by 20 percent through improvements in fleet fuel efficiency, and the use of alternative fuel vehicles (AFVs) and alternative fuels (AFs). In August 2005, the President signed the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (EPAct 2005). Numerous EPAct mandates include requirements that federal agencies acquire 75 percent of their light-duty fleet in Metropolitan Statistical Areas as AFVs, and that federal agencies use AF in all dual fuel vehicles. In an effort to comply with these mandates and highlight Job Corps fleet management policies, the National Office of Job Corps has designed fleet management training for Job Corps center fleet personnel.
- 3. <u>Action</u>. Mandatory training will be provided via conference call supplemented by a PowerPoint presentation. Please see the below schedule for the date and time of training for each center. Each contractor-operated center must select at least one staff member to participate in the call, and may have up to two staff members participate. Each participant should be located at a computer with PowerPoint capabilities, so they can access the training materials during the call. The dial in number for this training is (888) 955-5369.
