SUBJECT: Clarification of 6- and 12-Month Follow-up Survey Crediting Policy

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. This Program Instruction is being issued to clarify crediting policy for 6- and 12-month follow-up survey results in situations where the initial placement is identified as a Questionable Placement (QP) and is then found to be invalid by the Regional Office.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. Recently, several cases have arisen where a follow-up survey was administered to a graduate whose initial placement was later found to be invalid. This Program Instruction provides clarification regarding crediting for such situations in accordance with existing crediting stipulations in PRH Appendix 501.
- 3. <u>Guidelines</u>. If a credited initial placement is determined to be invalid through the QP process, the positive credit for that initial placement is replaced with a negative credit on all relevant report cards.

If the follow-up surveys capturing placement at the 6- and 12-month marks are conducted prior to the determination that the initial placement is invalid, the student is retroactively removed from the pool for the 6- and 12-month measures, since the student is not eligible to be surveyed. Thus, any credit (whether positive or negative) for the 6- and 12-month measures (as applicable) is also removed from all relevant report cards.

- 4. <u>Action</u>. Addresses are to ensure that a copy of this Program Instruction is distributed to the appropriate staff.
