SUBJECT:	Presidential \$1 Coin Act of 2005 (Public Law 109-145)

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To implement the use of \$1 coin-capable vending machines at contractor-operated centers in order to comply with Public Law 109-145.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. Section 104 of Public Law 109-145 (see attachment) is designed to help remove or alleviate remaining obstacles to the efficient and timely circulation of \$1 presidential coins by increasing access for these coins at sites where the federal government has influence over such decisions.
- 3. <u>Scope</u>. This provision of the law applies to all federally owned and/or operated sites.
- 4. <u>Action</u>. Center operators are required to ensure, no later than January 1, 2008, that vending machines on centers are \$1 coin capable and have signage indicating that the machines accept \$1 coins, to achieve compliance with the law.
