Angell has an innovative approach of storing the Thin Client on the shelf above the student. When the computers are not in use, the keyboard and mouse are placed out of the student's reach.

Keystone

Keystone has a space-saving island in the middle of the room. Note the pole in the middle of the island. This contains the electrical wiring for the Thin Clients so that no cords cross the floor.
