SUBJECT:	Training Achievement Record (TAR) updates
	for Program Year (PY) 2014

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To inform the Job Corps community of the TARs scheduled for review beginning January 2014.

2. <u>Background</u>. Annually, the Office of Job Corps, in close collaboration with industry and certification sponsors, monitors changes in the current industry standards and employment needs. This process ensures students are equipped with the most current knowledge and skills needed to meet labor demands.

3. <u>TAR Reviews</u>. To reflect these changes, the Office of Job Corps assembles TAR review teams consisting of Career Technical Training (CTT) instructors, National Training Contractors, credential sponsor and industry representatives, Regional Project Managers and subject-matter experts to review and recommend changes to existing TARs. This Program Instruction notice provides details regarding TAR reviews for PY 14 deployment. The Office of Job Corps will review and (where applicable) update the following 66 TARs based on new or amended national industry standards.

Program-specific Curriculum Change notices detailing deployment guidelines are forthcoming for all revised TARs. The TARs will be available through CITRIX (CIS-3G) by July 1, 2014, as electronic TARs (e-TARs).
