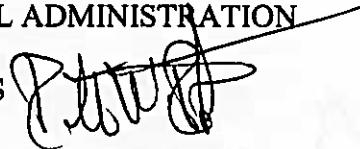

SUBJECT: Using UPS for Expedited Mail Services at Government-Negotiated Rates

1. **Purpose.** To restate and further define contractor requirements for using UPS expedited mail services.
2. **Background.** Early in 2017, the Office of Contracts Management issued a memorandum to Job Corps contractors directing a switch from FEDEX to UPS as a means to control express-service mail costs.
3. **Action.** To ensure prompt payment of UPS invoices, contractors were required to establish a consolidated bill-pay relationship between company financial department/office and UPS. This payment relationship needs to re-establish or be reconfirmed because there are 465 unpaid invoices that need to be settled.

Each contractor's financial department's complete address, a point of contact name and phone number, the UPS account number for each Job Corps location and the location's complete address must be included in the attached Excel worksheet.

Forward via e-mail the completed worksheets to Mark Risch (Risch.Mark@ups.com) and Tina Hess-Williams (hess-williams.tina@dol.gov) no later than August 24, 2017. All invoices that are received by the individual locations should be forwarded to their company financial office for payment.

4. **Expiration Date.** Until superseded.
