

Attachment D: Job Corps HSD Program of Study Requirements Checklist

General

- Courses have summative assessments
- Courses give final grades
- Course passing level ≥ 60 percent
- Credits only from
 - Transfers from accredited HS
 - Approved HSD programs
 - High School Equivalency (HSE) tests, as indicated below
 - CTT Training Program Area (TPA), as indicated below

Specifics

Requirement

English Language Arts

- Four credits
- Align with 9-12 CCSSⁱ

Additional Consideration

- Provider may award \leq two credits for passing GED RLA; or \leq one credit for passing HiSET/TASC Reading and \leq one credit for passing writing

Requirement

Mathematics

- Three credits, including one credit algebra I, one credit geometry
- Align with 9-12 CCSSⁱ

Additional Consideration

- Provider may award \leq one credit for passing GED/HiSET/TASC Math; this credit may not count for algebra or geometry.

Requirement

Social Studies

- Three credits, including \leq one credit American history, five credit civics or government

Additional Consideration

- Provider may award \leq one credit for passing GED/HiSET/TASC Social Studies; this credit may not count for American history or civics/government.

Requirement

Science

- Three credits, including one credit in laboratory courseⁱⁱ
- Align with 9-12 NGSSⁱ

Additional Consideration

- Provider may award \leq one credit for passing GED/HiSET/TASC Science; this credit may not count as the laboratory course.

Requirement

Overall

- Total credits: ≥ 22 , including all elements above and electives.

Additional Consideration

- Provider may award \leq one elective credit each for completion of up to two Career Technical Training Program areas.

ⁱ CCSS/NGSS or equivalent state-adopted standards must be at grade level.

ⁱⁱ Labs must minimally require 20 percent of course time.
