SUBJECT: LifeLoc Breathalyzer Utilization

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide the Job Corps community with guidance on how to use the LifeLoc FC10Plus breathalyzer units when there are health or safety concerns regarding alcohol consumption on center.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. In 2019, all centers received one breathalyzer unit and associated peripherals from LifeLoc, Inc. This PIN is to provide guidance on staff training and how to use the LifeLoc breathalyzers.

3. Action.

- a. Centers are to take the following actions before using the LifeLoc breathalyzer:
 - o Locate and unpack the unit and check for functionally.
 - Ensure the LifeLoc breathalyzer is calibrated in accordance with the
 manufacturer's guidelines. The unit's manual is available here https://lifeloc.com/pub/media/pdf/userManualFC10Plus.pdf. If the LifeLoc
 breathalyzer needs to be sent away for calibration, ensure there is an alternative
 method for assessing alcohol consumption, such as another functional
 breathalyzer or saliva screening tests while the unit is not available for use.
 - o Ensure all applicable center staff receive training on how to use this brand of breathalyzer. Centers can obtain training via the manufacture's website (to request a training email LifeLoc University at training@lifeloc.com and visit

https://lifeloc.server.tracorp.com/novusii/application/login/), local law enforcement/first responders, or a qualified local trainer. At a minimum, any existing and new staff who may utilize the breathalyzer (e.g., center security, safety, residential, and health and wellness staff) must have training in the use of the equipment. The center must maintain training records for audit purposes.

- Centers will begin using the LifeLoc FC10Plus breathalyzers issued in 2019 by the Office of Job Corps. Per PRH Section 2.3 R5, "all testing must be documented, and the results submitted to the health and wellness center" to be filed in the student health record.
- 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. Effective immediately until rescinded or superseded.
